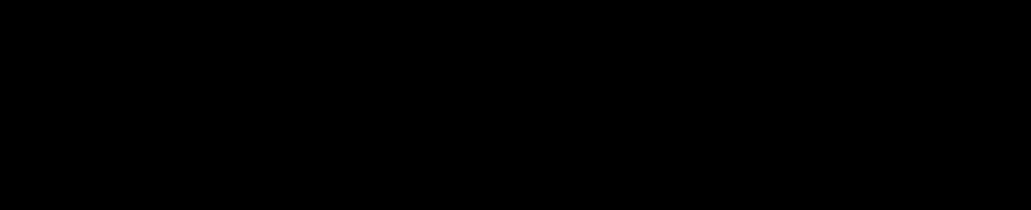

Comment Reasons:

Comment: I object to this development for the following reasons:

- the siting of this school on contaminated land which will put generations of young people's health at risk. As this was one of the reasons this site was discounted for the ASN school, it should also be unacceptable to put any other school there. This should be reason enough not to put the school there.
- the siting of the back gate at Middlemuir will lead to large volumes of traffic. These small streets are already challenging to drive through due to parked cars on the street, many large pot holes and cars parking on Moncrieff and Lomond for commuters using the train station. This will be the main entrance for all Lenzie pupils and the volume of traffic on these small quiet streets will be a huge safety risk to 100s of pupils walking to school.
- The removal of green space which is used on a daily basis for all generations of residents. I run through this park every other day and this space is always well used. This Green space cannot be replicated at the old Lenzie Academy site as suggested.
- the increased flooding risk, as per SEPA's concerns. These local roads already flood after heavy rain due to poorly maintained drains. The removal of this green space will exacerbate this issue for local residents.
