**Subject:** Objection to the proposed siting of the new Lenzie Academy at Whitegates Park

The loss of the much used and much loved and green space of Whitegates Park, which is a busy haven for wildlife, will impact the mental and physical health of the local population through all seasons of the year. At a time when conservation of our green spaces is becoming more critical it is disappointing to watch EDC systematically destroy nature in this way.

Whitgates Park, where the new build is planned, floods annually and the the flood water is oily and of a rusty colour. This does not seem to be addressed properly in the new plans or if it is deemed of adequate mitigation then the rise in costs of the new build will continue to grow as will future costs to keep this problem at bay.

Moving the current site in the middle of the community to the periphery of Lenzie will greatly increase traffic throughout Lenzie especially in the winter months as more parents will feel the need to drive to the periphery of Lenzie to drop their children off.
