I am writing to object to the plans for building Lenzie academy on Whitegates Park (Ref TP/ED/26/0104).

I am concerned for our green spaces in Lenzie. Many green spaces are being sold off, being built on or not being maintained. Losing Whitegates park will have a huge impact on wildlife, plants and trees.

My second concern is for the loss of recreational space - for dog walkers, cyclists, children safely playing and sports.

Building on this land would cause a greater flood risk.

The land is contaminated and would cause a public health risk. This land has already been rejected for a school build for this reason.

The build goes against planning policies that protect our open spaces.
