I noticed when I was communicating with Sports Scotland that I had missing in **row 248** :  
*"Routed over sports pitches to soft area."* is located on Page 19 of the document *Drainage Strategy Part 1.pdf*. It is found within *Table 4-1:200 and 1:1000 year rainfall event exceedance flows and consequences, specifically detailing the consequences of a 1:1000 year, 240-minute summer rainfall event at Node S5. Risk to pitches from contaminants in soil and clogging by ferruginous water*

Pease also that in **row 5** I refer to *The Localism Act 2011 (Section 25) & R (Lewis) v Redcar and Cleveland Borough Council [2008]*

When I should have referred to :

*Ethical Standards in Public Life etc. (Scotland) Act 2000, the Councillors' Code of Conduct (Section 7) - Declarations of Interest and Predetermination), and the common law principle of Administrative Fairness.*

Dear Mr. McMair,

I enclose my objection to planning application TP/ED/26/0104.

I have stated, "Why it matters, why it is a material consideration and why it is an objection to TP/ED/26/0104 OR why it demonstrates procedural unfairness or predetermination, and renders TP/ED/26/0104 unlawful."

It is a lengthy document with over 300 separate items.

I have enclosed an Excel version for your convenience and a PDF version and will deliver a printed copy to your offices.

I should also note that I fully support and am in agreement with the objection lodged by Planning Objections Scotland on behalf of Whitegates Park Community Group and the reports from Michael Dewar Associates.

I have separately lodged an objection to the Screening Direction; thank you for your acknowledgement of that.

I acknowledge that the Planning Department cannot adjudicate on matters such as predetermination, internal corporate governance failures, FOI breaches.

Therefore, if the Planning Authority deems the points in such categories to be 'non-material' to the land-use decision, I formally request that the Case Officer forwards any matters in such categories to the Council's Monitoring Officer for independent review under Section 5 of the Local Government and Housing Act 1989.

Furthermore, I request it to be formally noted in the Report to Committee that allegations of procedural predetermination and truncated options appraisals have been raised and referred to the Monitoring Officer, and indeed any other matters that fall within the remit of that officer.

I would be grateful if you could also, in the interests of transparency and democratic accountability, provide me with a spreadsheet containing a column annotating your reasons for accepting or rejecting each item, or describing to whom you have referred it.

I would imagine that this would be a necessary step in your internal process, so should not be irksome to you.
