I wish to object to the planning application of the new Lenzie Academy at Whitegates Park for the following

- Amenity - loss of protected open space.
- Design, height of building would cause significant harm to the character and appearance of the area. Size of building why is it not being built for the number of families who actually live in Lenzie rather than including the amount of placing requests East Dunbartonshire seems to take in. If it was built to a smaller size it would fit on the existing site and EDC wouldn't be legally bound to accept placing requests.
