Subject: Comments for planning app - new Lenzie Academy

I wish to register my OBJECTION to the planning application for the new Lenzie Academy. Like others I have been unable to do so via the online portal.

I strongly object to the loss of a well used park, and to the outrageous costs involved in developing this unsuitable site.

In addition I fail to understand how a traffic survey could recommend 110 cars using Middlemuir Rd and surrounding streets for picking up / dropping off to what is a hole in a wall. Hazel, Laurel, Middlemuir and Moncrieff are the suggested routes. This would severely impact access to Sycamore Ave, Lime Grove and Birch Drive at these times. Who is accountable if this prevents fire and ambulance service access? Moncrieff Ave has been suggested. This is barely passable now due to parking and there is a dangerous bend at the bottom into Douglas Ave and another into Lomond. These streets will not cope with an influx of 110 cars and will be gridlocked.

A tandem build would keep the park, be far more cost effective and would maintain existing access routes.
